Partial support in above table indicates

- Export template is supported
- One can create a fresh template, configure and apply it on the managed SFOS devices. But a template cannot be created by importing configuration from a firewall running on the respective SFOS version

Overview

Available to Sophos Partners, Sophos Central Firewall Manager (CFM) allows Partners to centrally manage and monitor Sophos Firewalls and is accessible from Sophos Central Partner.

Key Features

- Improvements in UX/UI
 - Improved layout and navigation that aligns with SFOSv16 and provides a more user friendly approach.
 - Full screen view to monitor more devices in single view on Device Monitor.
 - Better user experience on selecting custom group.
- Manage SF0S v16 features
 - Comprehensive management that allows to manage new features and workflow updates in SFOS v16 for Web Protection, Email Protection and more.
- RED S2S Wizard
 - Configure a RED Site-to-Site tunnel between a server and client in single workflow.
- Device Hostname
 - Option to configure Device hostname while adding devices in CFM via Device Discovery and from list of managed devices.
 - Notify via alert when hostname is changed.
- Device monitor & alerts now cover endpoints with Missing heartbeat.

Enhancements

Display the same list of IPS signatures in CFM at device level as visible on the individual Firewall Web Admin UI for given model.

Known Behavior

- OTP Management
 - Configuring OTP for administrator access of SFOS device breaks the communication between SFOS and CFM. It is recommended that you turn off the OTP feature for administrator access of SFOS device.
 - One cannot configure OTP functionality for all users via CFM at group level.
- Managing firewalls with SF0S v15.x
 - This CFM release allows to manage only SFOS v16 devices at group level. Manage firewall having SFOSv15.x on a per device basis (device level view)

Bug fixes

- NCCC-4468 Cannot apply configuration on a firewall after renaming a Firewall hostname from CFM at device level.
- NCCC-4409 Gateway status is displayed as disconnected (red) on CFM Device Monitor even if the Firewall Gateway is up.
- NCCC-4391 Route precedence applied from CFM template does not get updated on the Firewall CLI settings.
- NCCC-4159 Template in CFM cannot be deleted.
- NCCC-2217 Junk character displayed on CFM device level policy page instead of Japanese font.
