# **Bug Fixes**

- LDAP Authentication: GUI validation for password field missing. (NCR-2613)
- When integrated with LDAP for iView administrator authentication, the administrator LDAP password is visible as text in iView log files. (NCR-2539)
- Configuration backup over FTP does not work. (NCR-2667)
- Single Sign-on from SFM to iView is not working for users other than Super administrator. (NCR-2588)
- User is able to set password using special characters "11+β()1f1,.-A1111ÖÄÜ" in iView but not able to login using the same password. (NCR-2060)
- iView WebAdmin when accessed over HTTPS: Audit logs not displayed. (NCR-1806)
- Detail WebUser Reports: Records not displayed in some cases. (NCR-2290)
- Keyword search in Search Engine Reports does not display records. (NCR-2615)
- Sophos iView does not log blocked application attempts for some rules. (rule 60019) (NCR-2600)

- Email usage report does not display records. (NCR-2209)
- Unicode content not displayed. (NCR-2084)
- Scheduled Executive Report: Report data not displayed. (NCR-1824)
- Unable to resume a paused log digestion process after navigating to other page on UI. (NCR-2712)

# **Download Information**

Sophos Up2Date technology makes it easy for you to upgrade your Sophos iView v2 to the latest version.

You can use two methods to apply the available Up2Date package to the system:

### Method 1

- o Log in to your iView web interface.
- o Go to System > Maintenance > Firmware.
- Click "Check for new Firmware" to download the latest firmware.
- Once it is downloaded, click "Install" to begin the install. The system will reboot and the new firmware is installed.
- You can roll back to the previous firmware version by clicking "Boot Firmware" against the non-active firmware. Any configuration changes made between the upgrade and roll back will be lost.

### Method 2

- Download the Up2Date package from <u>MySophos</u>.
- o Go to System > Maintenance > Firmware.
- Select "Upload firmware" against the non-active firmware to upload the new firmware file and click "Upload & Boot". The system will reboot and the new firmware is installed.
- You can roll back to the previous firmware version by clicking "Boot Firmware" against the non-active firmware. Any configuration changes made between the upgrade and roll back will be lost.

**Note**: You must click **Check For New Firmware** option to upgrade your iView Beta (03.01.1.198) to iView GA (03.01.1.313).
