

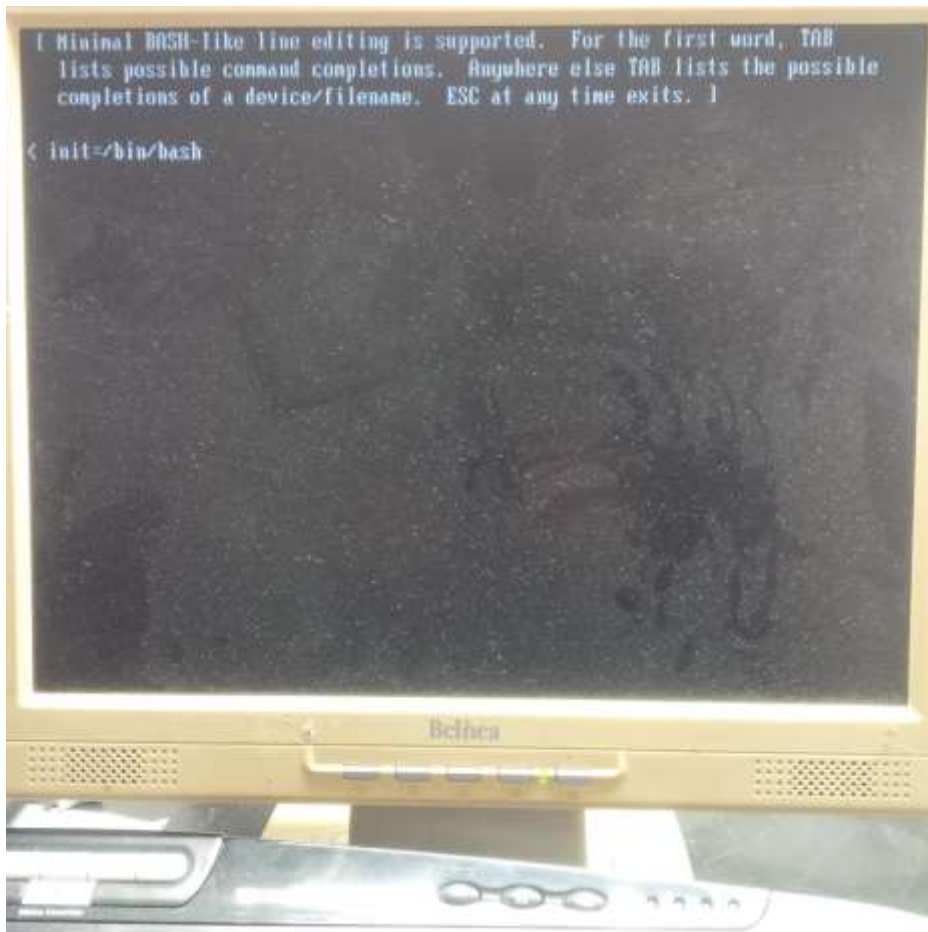
1. Start UTM and i pressed **esc** for choosing the UTM version -> see pic one ("local" connection)



2. I pressed **e** and selected with the arrow keys the second entry **kernel ...**



3. Pressed again **e** and I typed: **init=/bin/bash** and pressed **Enter**

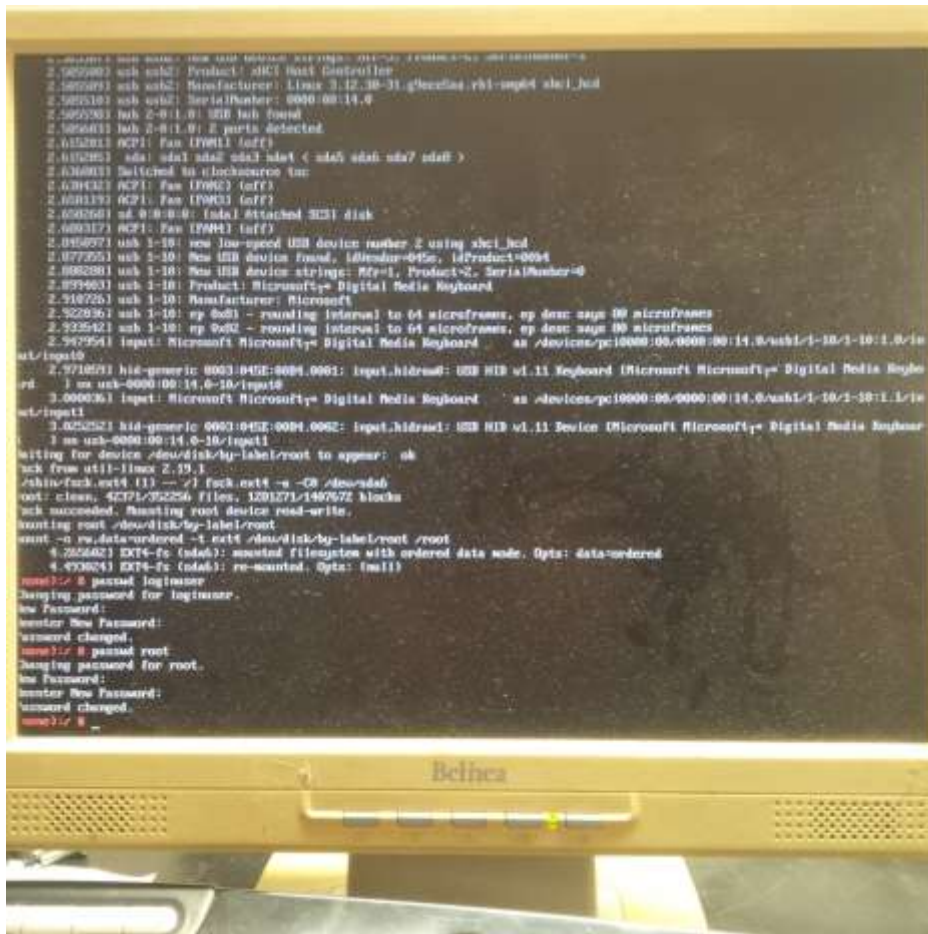


The following screen ...

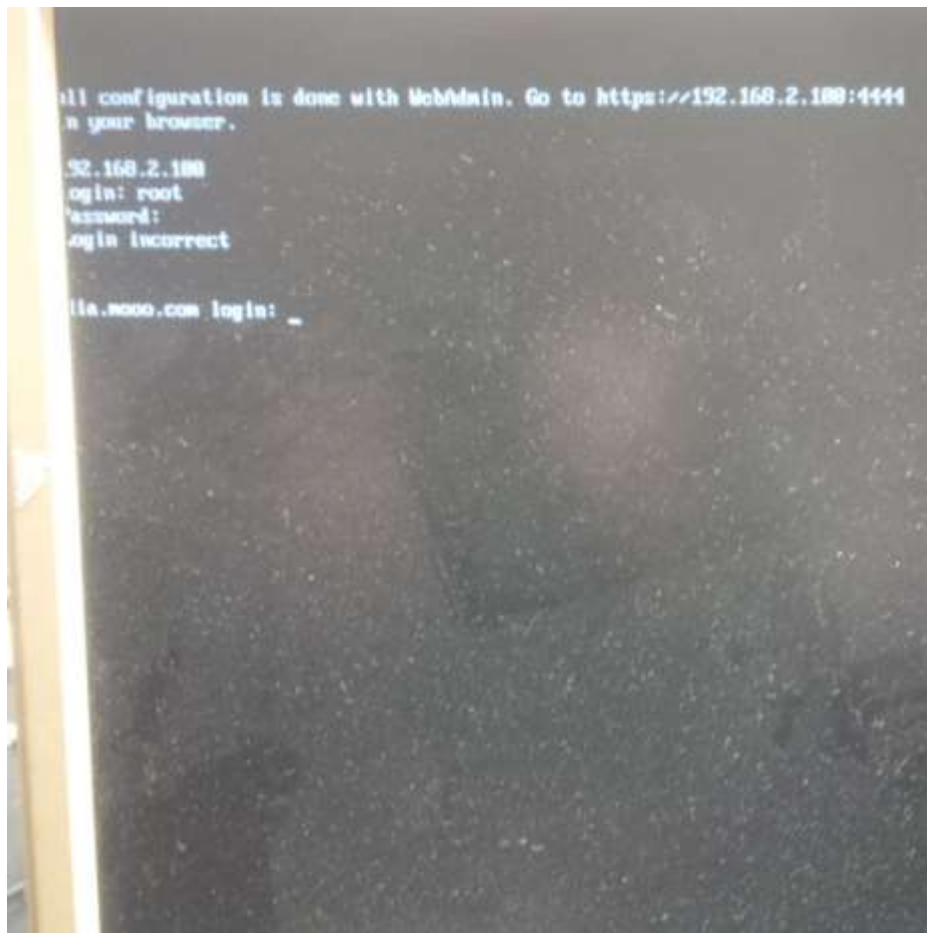


And I pressed **b**  
System was booting

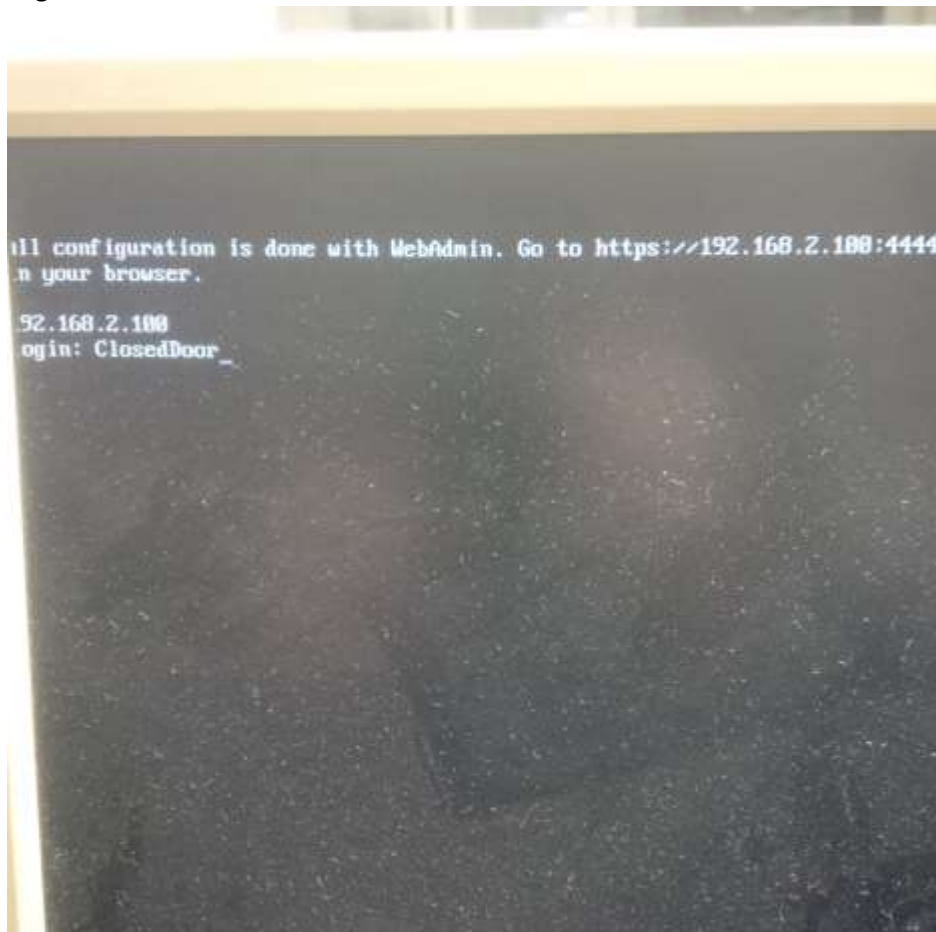
4. I typed ***passwd loginuser*** and I chose the password: ***ClosedDoor*** – also the same for root, see pic 6



5. ***Ctrl + Alt + Ent*** for the reboot



6. Login as root with ClosedDoor PW
